Joyce Elaine Wood, 93, of Pilot Point, TX passed away Monday, August 10, 2020 at her home. She was born June 4, 1927 in Palmer, TX to William "Bill" Everett and Lillian Gladys (Williams) McKeever.

Joyce graduated from Palmer High School at age 16, North Texas State Teachers College (now UNT) with a Bachelor of Science degree at age 19, and a Master of Education degree from North Texas State Teachers College at age of 24 in 1954. She spent 37 years in education: teaching second grade for one year in Collinsville, TX, one year to set up a department and teach home economics in Gunter, TX, and the remaining 35 years in home economics and Home Economics Cooperative Education (HECE) in Pilot Point. She saw many changes in education and served many students from this area. Added to that was 18 years as a school trustee and a total of 55 years of service in education. Joyce was married to E.B. "Buster" Wood on December 21, 1946 and moved to Pilot Point. He preceded her in death on October 18, 1996 after almost 50 years of marriage. Two children were born to this marriage, Leesa Gail Wood and Glen J Wood. Besides serving her local community for 55 years in education she served on these boards and organizations: Chamber of Commerce, Pilot Point ISD School Board (for 18 years), Economic Development Steering Committee, Lake Ray Roberts Rotary Club, Central Christian Church board, Goodfellows board, Pilot Point Community Opera House board, Pilot Point Museum board secretary, and the Pilot Point Community Cemetery Association. In Denton County she served on the RSVP and SPAN boards, and was active and an officer in the Retired Teacher's Association. On a state level, Joyce served two years as a Silver-Haired Legislator. She was a former member of the Elks Club, Senior Citizens Board Chair (where she helped get and build the Senior Center), Shepherd's Storehouse volunteer, and 4-H leader.

She helped organize and served on the Pilot Point ISD Educational Foundation board, Keep Pilot Point Beautiful, Main Street Committee and later the Historic Commission of Main Street. Joyce was the Main Street Committee Chair for the Texas First Lady's visit and had the trains stopped during the visit.

She was a sports enthusiast, and enjoyed history, quilting, travel, and people. Joyce was awarded the Pilot Point Citizen of the Year in 1995 and received other vocational and ISD

awards.

She is survived by her daughter, Leesa and husband Dr. Jim Calvi of Amarillo, TX; son, Glen and wife Jackie Wood of Pilot Point, TX; three grandchildren, Jennifer Calvi of Kansas City, MO, Jessica Calvi of Lincoln, NE, and Cody Jay and wife Rachel Wood of Denton, TX; and great-granddaughter, Rylee Wood.

Joyce was preceded in death by her parents, Bill and Lillian; and brother, Bill and his wife Sue.

Visitation will be held 6:30PM-7:30PM, Thursday, August 13, 2020 at Slay Memorial Chapel in Aubrey, TX. A funeral service will be held at 10:00AM, Friday, August 14, 2020 at Slay Memorial Chapel in Aubrey, TX. Burial will follow at Pilot Point Community Cemetery in Pilot Point, TX.
