



Alvin Lee Glover Sr.

April 3, 1939 - February 11, 2023

Alvin Lee Glover, Sr. (Al), passed away Saturday, February 11, 2023, in Oak Point, TX. Al was born April 3, 1939, in New Boston, TX to Phillip and Ruby (Lynch) Glover. He married Mary Belle Dixon on June 9, 1961, at Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Dallas, TX.

After graduating from New Boston High School in 1957 he moved to Dallas, TX and was employed at the Lone Star Gas Company and later the U.S. Postal Service. His Post Office career spanning over three decades began at the Downtown Dallas Post Office in 1959 as a letter carrier and later the Richardson Post Office where he worked as a clerk and in the back office. In 1983 he was appointed to the Postmaster position in Little Elm, Texas and worked there until his retirement in 1992.

He served in the United States Army from November 1961 to November 1963. He was an excellent cook and was soon promoted to an E-5 level.

His love for the outdoors showed through his beautiful flower beds, his hearty gardens and his plentiful pecan and fruit trees. He loved dancing and never hesitated to dance at any event that provided music. He worked as a volunteer for the Kiwanis Club, the Lions Club and the Boy Scouts of America.
