She also helped to form the Aubrey Area Museum which continues to serve the community by providing an extensive historical knowledge of the founding families and

history of our wonderful city.

Carolyn was a very civic minded person who left many gifts, and tradition for Aubrey citizens. Beyond all the wonderful contributions to the community that Carolyn worked so hard to form, she was also devoted to her family. A loving wife to her husband Kenneth for 57 years, she was also a mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, cousin, niece, and friend who will be missed very much. She left not only a legacy for Aubrey to enjoy but lasting memories for her family as well.
