Connor Chesley Slocum, 19, of Aubrey, TX, was a passenger involved in a fatal automobile accident, and passed away Thursday, June 17, 2021 in Duncan, OK. Connor was born on March 25, 2002 in Bedford, TX to Charles Cody Slocum and Tara Leigh Lowry. Connor graduated from Ryan High School in the top 5% of his class in 2020.
