May 12, 1927 - March 29, 2014

Donald Bell, 86 of Aubrey, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, March 29, 2014. He was born May 12, 1927 to Henry and Bessie (Phinney) Bell in the community of Spring Hill. He married Mary Nell Wilson on November 1, 1956 in Denton County. He proudly served in the United States Army during WWII. He was a member of the Aubrey ISD School Board and was instrumental in the construction of the first Aubrey High School. Donald was a long time peanut farmer, and last served as an adviser at Starr's Service Station. He was a beloved father and grandfather.
