Dorothy Jean Stuckey, 93, of Pilot Point, TX, passed away Wednesday, January 11, 2023

Dorothy was born in Tioga, TX on October 14, 1929, to Earl and Ora Clark.

She graduated from Tioga High School in 1949 as salutatorian of her class.

Dorothy married J.D. O'Dell on August 6, 1949. They lived in Pilot Point and at the Rock Creek Marina on Lake Texoma until the passing of J.D.

On May 29, 1976, Dorothy married Ray Stuckey. They made their home in Pilot Point.

Dorothy began working at the Russell Newman sewing factory in Pilot Point in 1958. Twenty-nine years later, she retired as a supervisor.
