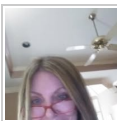
I am so sorry for your loss sally you and larry where perfect together but I hope you know there is no doubt he is in heaven riding horses along with his old mare

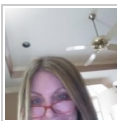
