Edyth Ann Lewis passed away peacefully on Feb. 6th, 2026, after a 4-yr journey with dementia. Up until the end, Ann maintained her kindness, grace, compassion, and love of family and friends.

Ann was born on Nov 17, 1932, in Denton, TX. She graduated High School in 1949 and then graduated from North Texas State College, which is now the University of North Texas, in 1953 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Education. She was a member of the Zeta Tau Alpha Sorority during her time in college. In 1954, Ann married her long-time sweetheart Dr. Bert Lewis. She taught school in the Dallas Independent School District up until her daughter Carole Ann was born in 1958. This was followed by a son Daniel Philip Lewis in 1962. She retired from teaching in 2001 after some health issues sidelined her permanently. In 2002, Ann moved back to Denton, where she lived independently until about 2018 when a serious fall sent her to a nursing home where she lived until her passing on Feb 6th, 2026.
