Harrylou Daniel Lewis was born in Blanchard, OK on September 18, 1938, to Harry and Bertress (Hood) Daniel. She passed from this life in Denton, TX on September 4, 2023, at the age of 84.

She was raised in Blanchard and graduated from Blanchard High School. She married Wade Lewis in 1957 and they were blessed with 3 children: Gary, Shelly, and Dan. She was the youngest of 6 children. Her parents were early pioneers of Blanchard; and her mother taught in Blanchard schools for many years.
