



Israel Trevino Moya

February 8, 1974 - March 9, 2026

It is with sadness that we announce the passing of Israel Trevino Moya on March 9, 2026, at the age of 52. He was born on February 8, 1974, in Dallas, Texas.

Israel Trevino Moya honorably served in the United States Navy for over 20 years, entering active duty on June 22, 1993, and retiring on June 30, 2013, with the rank of Aviation Machinist's Mate Chief (ADC). Over the course of his career, he completed 2 years and 11 months of foreign service and more than 10 years of sea service. He advanced to Chief Petty Officer on December 16, 2007. His decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (3), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (6), Good Conduct Medal (6), National Defense Service Medal (2), Global War on Terrorism Service Medal (1), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal (1), Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal (1), Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (5), Navy and Marine Corps Overseas Service Ribbon (2), Navy "E" Ribbon (2), and the Navy Recruiting Service Ribbon (2), as well as the Kuwait Liberation Medal. His military education included Recruit Training, Primary Leadership Development Program, EA-6B Prowler organizational maintenance training, and First Line Leadership Development, among other courses.

His hobbies included singing and playing drums.

He is survived by his wife, Mely Moya; and his children, Damian Salazar, Ismael Moya, Isaac Moya, Ivaan Moya, Israel Jr. Moya, Brianna Moya, Brenda Moya, and Hazel Moya. He is also survived by his mother Martha Trevino; his

sisters, Esmeralda Moya, Martha Cano, Issa Moya, and Rhina Moya; and his brothers, Alejandro Moya, Javier Moya, and Jesus Moya. He was a grandfather to seven grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by Macedonio Moya.

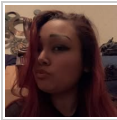
