



## Jerry Ronald Walker

November 10, 1969 - January 17, 2017

Detective Jerry Ronald Walker, 47, ended his watch in the line of duty Tuesday, January 17, 2017 in Denton, TX. He was born on November 10, 1969 in Tyler, Texas. Jerry graduated from J.P. Taravella High School in 1989. He went on to serve in the US Army during Operation Desert Storm. Jerry became a law enforcement officer with the Little Elm Police Department in 1998 where he was presently serving as a detective. Jerry is survived by his children, Darien Walker, Landon Walker, of Little Elm; Jace Walker of Frisco, and Lexi Walker of Little Elm; mother and father, Beverly & Robert Walker of Houston; father, Jerry R. Bragg of Brownsboro; sisters, Peisha Ortiz of Pembroke Pines, FL, Neala Rankin of West Sacramento, CA, Danielle Walker of Conroe and Amanda Bragg of Pilot Point; brother, Bryan Bragg of Houston; Grandmothers, Louise Guthrie of Eustace, and Louise Walker of Salt Lake City, UT; girlfriend, Hali Grooms of Little Elm.
