John Dixon McDavid, 89, of Frisco, TX, passed away Tuesday, May 19, 2020 in Frisco, TX. He was born November 20, 1930 in Oak Park, IL to John S. and Dorthea B. (Kelly) McDavid. John married Mary Evelyn Miller on June 25, 1982 in Dallas, TX.

John attended Oak Park and River Forest High School and was on the swimming and golf teams. In 1952, earned a BS in Geology at Colorado College.
