Judith Pamela Ramsey, 82, of Aubrey, TX, passed away Friday, August 29, 2025 in Dallas, TX. Judith was born March 2, 1943 in Dallas to Joseph Russell and Elizabeth Katherine (Smith) Green. She married Frank Thomas Ramsey in Grand Prairie, TX on January 17, 1963.

From a young age, Judith prayed for a husband who would be happy and laugh all the time. She met her husband, Frank, one summer in 1961 after graduation, at Lou Ann's Drive-in in Dallas, TX. She always said had she been one second either way, she would have missed him. He was sitting on the back of a convertible Corvette visiting from De Queen, AR. She loved him from the moment they met, and his laugh was exactly what she had prayed for. They were married 44 years and dated 2 years before marriage. Even after he died in 2007, Judith wore her ring and said she was still married. There would never be anyone else for her.
