Kemp McMillan, 83, of Pilot Point, TX, passed away Friday, January 1, 2021 in Denton, TX. He was born February 8, 1937 in Snyder, TX to Elvis and Alta (Kemp) McMillan. Kemp married Barbara F. Holman on August 24, 1963 in Snyder, TX and he served in the United States Army.

His two daughters describe him as their hero. On weekend days Kemp would often tell Barbara, "I sure am glad I know how many kids I have, when we wake up to a houseful, of girls".

Kemp's four grandchildren have said many times that their Pa could fix anything. Their Pa has fixed toys, built playhouses, fixed fishing rods, bandaged knees, and also broken a few parental rules and freed them from chores, being grounded, and allowing a few extra treats when he was "in charge."

Many describe Kemp as the salt of the earth; he is an Army veteran, he has helped build churches, feed the masses, change many flat tires; simply put, if you were in need, Kemp would come to your aid. Kemp never knew a stranger and had an infectious smile that could calm a storm.

Kemp will be greatly missed, but has left a legacy through his friends and family that will carry on for generations to come.
