Kierstin Eaddy, 14, of Flower Mound passed away Sunday, July 20, 2014 from injuries received at an organized karting event. Kierstin was born May 22, 2000 to Todd and DeVonna Eaddy in Grapevine, Texas. Kierstin met life with passion and determination. She was a student at June Shelton School in Dallas where she participated in soccer and track and field. Kierstin was part of breaking several school records this past school year. She represented Kodiak Track and Field Club this summer in the USATF Junior Olympics. Kierstin had received the "Spirit of Shelton" award , the highest award a student may receive, from the June Shelton School this spring. She was a Girl Scout, volunteered with SpiritHorse Therapeutic Riding Center in Corinth. Kierstin was an avid kart enthusiast and had been racing since she was seven. She owned her pre-assembled kart and wanted to become an engineer and design her own automobile. A fund has been set up in Kierstin's name to support SpiritHorse International in Corinth, Texas and the June Shelton School of Dallas. Reference; giveforward.com key word; Kierstin Eaddy. Kierstin is survived by her parents Todd and DeVonna Eaddy of Flower Mound; sister, Natalie Eaddy also of Flower Mound; her paternal grandmother, Shirley Eaddy of Flower Mound; and maternal grandfather, Daryl Goodenough of Weyerhaeuser, WI.
