Lee Massie Gills, 62, beloved brother, father, and husband, passed away peacefully, May 29, 2023, surrounded by his family, due to complications of Parkinson's disease, in Aubrey, TX. Lee was the son of Russell Aubrey Gills, Jr. and Page Beck Gills. He was born in Virginia Beach, VA on July 15, 1960.
