



## LH Kruger

May 24, 1924 - July 23, 2021

LH Kruger, 97, of Aubrey, TX, passed away Friday, July 23, 2021 in Aubrey. He was born May 24, 1924 in Aubrey, TX to Henry and Lela (Sauls) Krueger. LH married Willie Mae Wilson on November 10, 1945 in Decatur, TX. She preceded him in death on February 17, 2015. LH later married Doris Marie Patterson in Aubrey, TX on August 25, 2017. LH served in the United States Army during World War II.

In 1964 LH Kruger purchased 328 acres of land off of Highway 377 just south of Aubrey, TX, which became the community of Krugerville. In 1973 the city of Krugerville was incorporated.
