November 11, 1919 - July 1, 2014

Clifton Irick, 94, of Pilot Point, passed away Tuesday, July 1, 2014 at his home with his family present in Pilot Point, TX. He was born November 11, 1919 in Munday, TX to Travis and Nell (Chamberlain) Irick. Clifton married Bertha Nadene Stephens on March 14, 1942 in Pilot Point, TX. Clifton served his country in the US Army Air Corps. He was president of the school board when the Gee School was built. He was a charter member of the Pilot Point Chamber and former president, charter member of the American Legion, charter member of the Kiwanis Club that was organized in 1958, member of the Pilot Point VFD for over 20 years and served as secretary. Clifton was a former mayor of Pilot Point and was a member of Calvary Baptist Church since 1939.
