Michele Renee Miles (54) sadly passed away at her dream home in Aubrey, Texas on April 25, 2022. An exceptional student, she attended Northside High School where she graduated valedictorian in 1985. With her exceptional talents and magnetic personality, Michele left a lasting impact on her loved ones and the world,
