Nellie Lola Hall, 92, passed away Thursday, September 27, 2018 in Denton, TX. Visitation will be held 3:00 PM – 5:00 PM, Saturday, September 29, 2018 at Slay Memorial Center in Aubrey, TX. A graveside service will be held on Sunday, September 30, 2018 at 3:00 PM at Tioga Cemetery and a celebration memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, October 6th at Third Church of Christ, Scientist, 4419 Oak Lawn Avenue in Dallas, Texas. Nellie was born on April 19, 1926 to Nellie and Cebron Jones of Chamblee, Georgia. After marrying her children's father in 1942, she spent 26 years as a stay-at-home mother in Georgia.
