Paul Edward Dworak, 74, of Aubrey, TX, passed away Friday, July 4, 2025 in Aubrey, TX. Paul was born January 25, 1951 in Natrona, PA to Edward and Sophia (Wygonik) Dworak.

Paul graduated from St. Joseph High School in Natrona, PA and went on to attend Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, PA. He earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA), a Master of Fine Arts (MFA), and a Doctorate (Ph.D.) in Music. A dedicated educator and accomplished scholar, Paul served as a professor of music theory at the University of North Texas for over 30 years, where he mentored generations of students and contributed significantly to the academic and artistic community.
