Richard James Taylor, 81, passed away Wednesday, September 3, 2014 in Denton, TX. He was born July 8, 1933 in Milltown, WI to Ora and Abbie (Peach) Taylor. Richard married Delores Preussler on June 22, 1957 in Coquille, OR. Richard served in the US Navy. "Dick" raised his family with Delores in Concord, CA where he worked for the Mount Diablo Unified School District as an elementary school principal for 33 years. During this time he was a member of the Walnut Creek Evangelical Church (now named NorthCreek Church) and served as Elder for many of those years. In retirement, Dick and Delores moved to Rocklin, CA, becoming members of Creekside Church, where he again served as Elder for more than 10 years. During this time they were active members in the Springfield senior community in which they lived.
