Shea Lyn Dane, 52, of Pilot Point, TX, went home to be with the Lord Monday, October 10, 2022. Shea was born September 4, 1970 in Denton, TX to Bobby and Kay (Bullington) Dane.

Shea was a 1988 graduate of J. Earl Selz High School in Pilot Point, and she was a cheerleader, a member of Beta club and the rodeo team. She also graduated from Texas State University, formally Southwest Texas State University, with a degree in criminal justice. After graduation, she was a parole officer for the City of Dallas. Shea later worked at Tri-Tex Cabinets becoming general manager in 2015. She served her community as a member of the Pilot Point city council for four years, then mayor of Pilot Point for eight years.

Shea married Wes Patterson of Pilot Point in 2005. They were blessed with two beautiful children Jacob Paul Patterson and Emma Grace Patterson. She is survived by her two children; mother, Kay of Argyle, TX; brother, Kelly Dane and wife Misty of Dallas, TX; sister, Allison Dane of Pilot Point, TX; three aunts, Emma Perry of Denton, TX, Marcy Pace of Denton, TX, and Nolene Harrell of Euless, TX; and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

Shea was preceded in death by her father, Bobby; and grandparents, Jake and Elsie Dane and Noel and Afton Bullington.

Visitation will be held 6:30PM-8:00PM, Thursday, October 13, 2022 at Slay Memorial Chapel in Aubrey, TX. 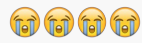
