



## Spencer John Loalbo

March 2, 1984 - June 8, 2025

Spencer John Loalbo, 41, of Double Oak, TX passed away on Sunday, June 8, 2025, in Celina, TX. Spencer was born on March 2, 1984, in San Antonio, TX to Robert Edward and Karen Rene (Tanner) Loalbo. He lived a life marked by love, adventure, and a deep compassion for others.

On September 27, 2014, Spencer married the love of his life, Kaylee Ann Blevins. Together they built a life centered on faith, family, and unwavering love for each other. He was a devoted husband, a loving father, and a loyal friend.

Spencer was happiest outdoors – hunting, camping with his family, and fishing. Saltwater fishing was his favorite. He was a Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching football. In the winter, he loved the thrill of snowboarding and the peace of the mountains. A true Texan at heart, he loved Mexican food and never passed up chips, salsa, and tableside guacamole!

Spencer's faith was the cornerstone of his life. After fully giving his heart to Jesus, he devoted himself to living a life that reflected Christ's love. His greatest mission in life was to point people towards Jesus – not just with words, but with action. He also instilled that same love for Jesus into his children, guiding them with grace, prayer, and a deep desire for them to know and walk with the Lord.

One story captures the essence of who Spencer was: During a homeless outreach, he encountered a woman in a wheelchair. It was cold outside, and her socks were wet. Spencer knelt in front of her, encouraged her, prayed for her, and then gently removed her wet socks. He took off his own shoes and socks and placed them on her feet. With bare feet, he returned to the car in tears from the overwhelming compassion he felt for her. That moment was a pure reflection of his heart – a servant’s heart that sought to love like Jesus. It was a powerful glimpse into the soul of the man he had become.

Spencer leaves behind a legacy of faith, kindness, humility, and love. His presence will be deeply missed but his memory will live on in the hearts of all who knew and loved him.

Spencer is survived by his wife, Kaylee; three daughters, Evelyn, Charlotte, and Nora; parents, Robert and Karen Loalbo of Lake Kiowa, TX; one brother, Jason Loalbo and wife Staci of San Antonio, TX; two nephews, Logan and Landon Loalbo of San Antonio, TX; two nieces, Skylar and Josephine Loalbo of San Antonio, TX; uncles, Joe Loalbo and wife Sandy of Coventry, CT, Michael Loalbo of Bloomington, IN, Mike Tanner and wife Connie of Murfreesboro, TN, and Danny Tanner and partner Beth of Clarksville, TN; and father-in-law and mother-in-law, Harold and Pam Blevins of Aubrey, TX.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Edward and Marguerite Loalbo; maternal grandparents, Bobby and Clara Tanner; and aunt, Patricia Loalbo.

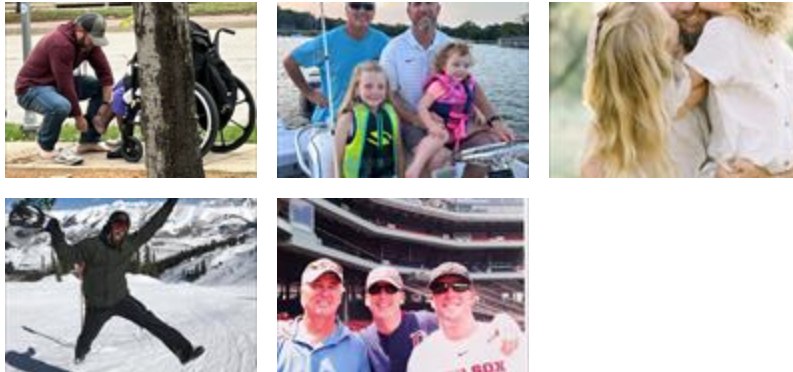
