



## Steven Lloyd Stout

September 26, 1964 - March 11, 2018

Steven Lloyd Stout, 53-year old beloved son of Bobby and Earlene Stout, died peacefully on March 11, 2018 in Aubrey, TX. He was born September 26, 1964 in Denton, TX. Steven lived his entire life in Aubrey and was loved by all who knew him. A graduate of Aubrey High School, Steven came from a legacy of farmers and would often sell vegetables at farmers' markets. Over the decades, his smiling face was ever present in and around Aubrey – at football games, church socials, BBQs and community gatherings. During his teen years, he could be found at his Grandpa Earl Deeds' feed store. Later in life, he worked at the peanut dryer and then for 12 years he fixed flats and everything else at Garry Starr's Service Station, aka The Rock Station. Listening to hours of tall-tales while at the Rock Station earned Steven his nickname of "Smiley." Helping other people in any way he could was integral to Steven's life. In his younger years, he was part of the Aubrey Volunteer Fire Department and was often the first person to show up for a brisket fundraiser or a community event. Whatever the cause, Steven was there to help including being willing to laugh at jokes, even if he had heard them a dozen times before. Smiles, laughter and hugs came easily to him. Steven was an avid follower of country music and loved traveling to Branson, Missouri. He attended the First Baptist Church in Krugerville, TX. He is survived by his parents, Bobby and Earlene of Aubrey, TX, an extended family and countless friends. He was preceded in death by his brother, Michael Stout.
