



## Thomas Joseph Currier, MD

September 6, 1938 - August 18, 2019

Dr. Thomas Joseph Currier, 80, of Aubrey, TX, passed away Sunday, August 18, 2019. He was born September 6, 1938 in San Francisco, CA to Thomas Joseph and Kathleen (Weaver) Currier. Thomas married Viktoriya Polyachenko on February 8, 2008 in Valley View, TX. He had a Masters in Computer Science and Mathematics from the University of Southern Mississippi and a Medical Degree from the University of Texas, San Antonio. Thomas was a retired United States Air Force colonel who had served for 26 years. He served as a doctor in the military and was an OB/GYN in Cooke County for 40 years.
