Many of his acts of kindness were personal to him, and he wanted no “credit” for them. He has held many jobs, but his favorite was at StoneMark where he was a “superstar,” as in many other facets of his life.

Tim's "demon" was an addiction to pain pills, following the surgeries incurred in college. He fought the demons his whole life. On the other hand, he is not ever to be "known only" with this description, as he was a man of amazing character and worth.

Tim loved the Savior, with whom he held a personal relationship. He led many men to Christ and praised Jesus in everything he did. As his parents, we are so confident we will see him again, one day appointed by Jesus, in Heaven. It is because of the Cross, that we can have this faith!
