



## Virgie Charlene Missildine

Virgie “Charlene” Missildine, 75, passed into The Lord's presence Wednesday, May 13, 2026, in Frisco, TX. Charlene was born September 23, 1950, in Athens, TX to Charlie and Opal (Chapman) Spurgeon. She married the love of her life, Ted Missildine III, November 3, 1972, in Athens, TX.

Charlene is preceded in death by her parents Charlie and Opal.

Those remaining to cherish her memories are her husband, Ted Missildine III of Oak Point, TX; son, Ted Missildine IV of Oak Point, TX; grandchildren, Daniella, Audrina and Ethan Missildine; sister, Wanda Gray of Frisco, TX.

and moving out of state. Years later, she returned to Victoria, and Victoria Christian School, teaching primarily third grade for 19 years. Charlene touched the hearts of hundreds of young children, encouraging them to love her Lord Jesus. And since lives touch lives, she surely impacted thousands for eternity.
