Virgie Elaine (Ogle) Tischler, 84, of Pilot Point, passed away on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, in Southlake, TX. She was born on April 24, 1942, in Jacksboro, TX, to Virgil and Opal (Deweber) Ogle.
